OVERVIEW

You will first attend the two-day G-317-CERT course. Once completed, you are eligible to join the team. This team is ready to respond to a disaster in and around the region.

You will provide support to Sachse Fire-Rescue during structure fires and City events.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

There are various city events that CERT has the opportunity to assist with including Fallfest, Pumpkin Prowl, and Pancakes with Santa.

DISASTER SUPPORT

After you and your family are secure and safe, you may be called upon to help during a disaster and assigned duties based on your knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Depending on your skill-set, you may be assigned to a hazard zone, wide area searches, clerical tasks, or other areas that may need extra support.

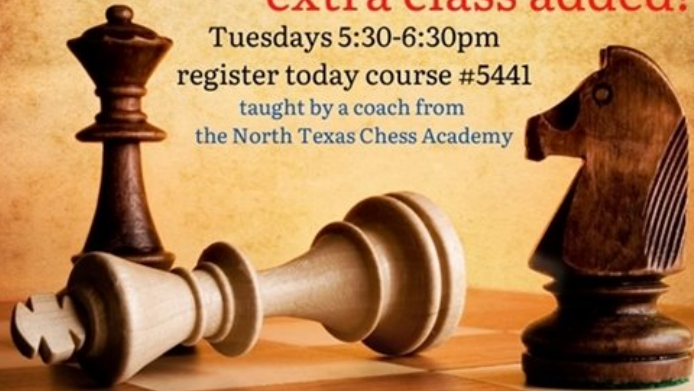

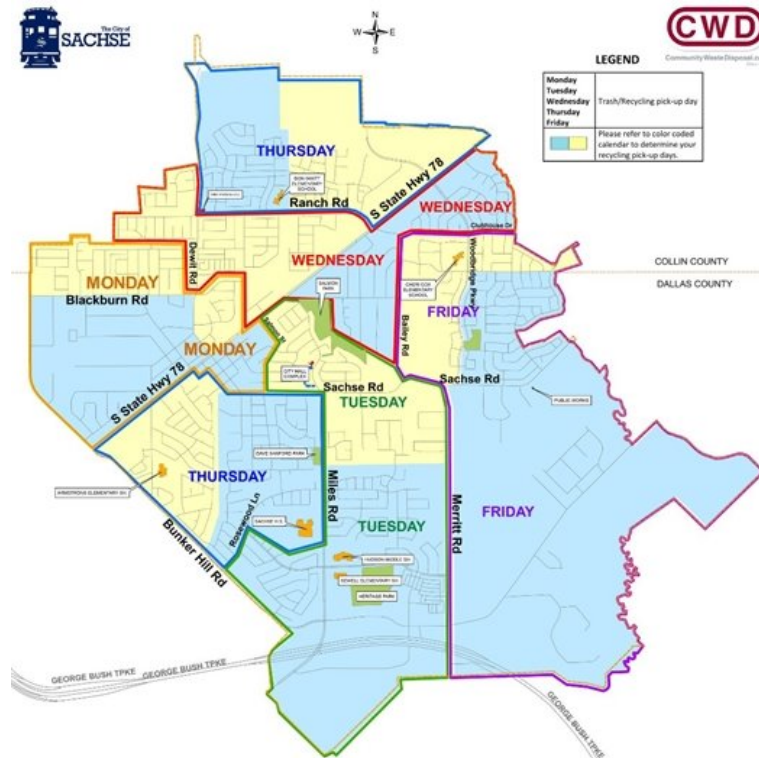

Discover Your Bulk & Brush Collection Day

The City has new times to set out your bulk trash and brush collection. Bulk trash needs to be placed out no earlier than 48 hours prior to your scheduled collection day. What about brush? It goes out on the Saturday prior to your collection day.

Please Note: no more than 6 cubic yards of brush/bulk are allowed to be out on the curb at one time.
