There are approximately 793 homes, and an industrial area containing businesses in AOR 4 (see the map on the back). This Area is located in the middle portion of Sachse and experiences relatively little crime throughout the year.

Traffic can be a concern in AOR 4 because it includes portions of Highway 78, Ranch Rd and Ingram Rd with Ranch Rd. being the primary route to Don Whitt Elementary.

Residents in AOR 4 should be aware of traffic and not use Ranch Rd. during the weekday mornings and afternoons when school traffic is heaviest.
