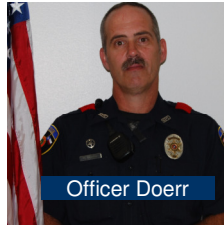

There are approximately 767 homes and an Elementary School in AOR 5. This Area is located in the North East portion of Sachse and experiences relatively little crime throughout the year.

Traffic can be a concern in Area 5 because it includes portions of Woodbridge Parkway, Country Club Drive, and Creek Crossing, which is the primary route to Cox Elementary. Residents in AOR 5 should be aware of traffic and not use Creek Crossing during the weekday mornings and afternoons when school traffic is heaviest.
