### **Public Content**

#### **BACKGROUND**

In May 2017, the City of Sachse voters approved the initial adoption of the Street Maintenance Tax, which is a method of funding street maintenance projects through the local sales tax. State law requires that the sales and use tax to be readopted every four years through an election. Therefore, on February 1, 2021, the City Council ordered a Special Election for the adoption of a local sales and use tax in the City of Sachse, Texas at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. As a result, the City contracted with Dallas County and Collin County to hold an election on Saturday, May 1, 2021.

#### **OVERVIEW**

In order to declare the results official, the City Council must canvass the results. The proposed ordinance will declare the results for Proposition A: Authorizing the adoption of a sales and use tax in the City of Sachse, Texas, at the rate of one-fourth (1/4) of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.
