

Sachse Public Library 3D Printer Use Policy

- Patrons 18 years of age and older who have a Sachse Public Library card in good standing may submit a design in the form of an .stl file to be printed using the Library's 3D printer. Patrons with expired library cards or owing fines greater than \$5.00 will not be permitted to use the Library's 3D printing services until such time as they have an active Sachse Public Library card with a balance of less than \$5.00.

- Patrons may not use the 3D printer to create objects that are:
 - Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
 - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others
 - Obscene, disparaging, or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment
 - In violation of another's intellectual property rights, including materials that are subject to copyright, patent, or trademark protection
 - Too large or too detailed to be completed during hours in which the Library is open

- The Sachse Public Library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.

- The Sachse Public Library reserves the right to limit commercial or other use in connection with making the 3D printer available to all patrons.

- Patrons are responsible for the design of objects to be printed, and staff will not modify designs for any reason. Library staff will notify patrons if a design is unprintable.

- Library staff will notify patrons once their print has been completed and the item is ready for pick-up. Items not picked-up by the patron within seven days will become property of the Library, and the printing fees will be added to the patron's library card account.
