

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 7, 2020 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A COUNCILMEMBER PLACE 4 TO FILL AN UNEXPIRED TERM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that the notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election, and;

WHEREAS, it is imperative to consider the returns of the election held on January 7, 2020, for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been duly and legally made and submitted to the City Council for canvassing, and a tabulation of the returns for the polling place and for early voting, as canvassed and tabulated by this governing body for the election of Councilmember Place 4, as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Said election was duly called, that notice of said notice was given in accordance with the law, and that said election was held in accordance with the law.

SECTION 2. No candidate received the majority of votes cast to be elected as Councilmember Place 4. Chance Lindsey and Drew Shubzda received the highest number of votes for the office. Therefore, a runoff election shall be called for the election of Councilmember Place 4.

SECTION 3. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.


